


APPLICATION: JEEP LIBERTY (KJ)

CAUTION! Before connecting the block heater/cordset to a power source, be sure that the element is immersed in coolant. NEVER energize heater in the open air. The element sheath could burst.


■ Drain coolant from the radiator and cylinder block and save for re-use. Refer to cooling system draining procedure in the service manual.

CAUTION! Make sure that vehicle has completely cooled off before starting the install.




## 2.4L ENGINE CORDSET INSTALL:


■ Route cordset upward and attach in-line push clip to hole in the air cleaner mounting bracket. CAUTION! Make sure that cordset is positioned away from the exhaust manifold.



- Attach cordset in-line receptacle clip onto existing strut tower servo mounting stud.
- Route cordset forward and attach in-line tie strap to headlamp/cowl harness.
- Refill cooling system with the retained coolant. Start engine and check for leaks at the block heater.

## 3.7L ENGINE CORDSET INSTALL:

- Lower the vehicle and open the hood.
- Route cordset upward along engine harness. Attach in-line tie strap to the harness.
- Attach cordset in-line receptacle clip onto frontmost valve cover stud.
- Route cordset rearward along the bottom of engine cooling hose. Attach in-line tie strap to the hose.
- Refill cooling system with the retained coolant. Start engine and check for leaks at the block heater.
